## Environmental Health Fee Schedule and Description

<b>Sewage Systems</b>	
<p><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Subsurface Sewage Permit- New</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A permit is required for new systems or new location of an *approved system.</li> <li>• A review of soil types is made at proposed location for actual septic system</li> <li>• Sizing of the drainfield and septic tank is determined.</li> <li>• Permit approval depends on the following: the predicted maximum daily sewage flow; house size and location; well / spring location; surface water locations; depth to groundwater on limiting layers; changes to native soil (road cuts, grading, benching); distance to neighboring structures (wells, buildings, drainfields); proposed land use; soil type; other issues of concern.</li> <li>• Permits to construct a septic system are not granted until all such issues are addressed and / or submitted in writing as part of the plot plan / permit application and found to be consistent with current regulations.</li> <li>• Permit applications are for 1 year (No Renewal).</li> <li>• <b>Septic Permits are valid one (1) year from date of issuance.</b></li> <li>• No partial refund is made if fieldwork is done but a permit cannot be approved.</li> </ul>	<b>\$950</b>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Speculative Site Evaluation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Consists of a review of soil types on property.</li> <li>• <i>Used for planning purposes only</i> and does not constitute approval or disapproval of a site.</li> <li>• Fee can be applied to a septic permit if application is made within one year.</li> </ul>	<b>\$400</b>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Individual System Permit – Expansion</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For projects with an increase in flow that requires the *approved drainfield to be expanded greater than 10%, which may include a new septic tank. Must be able to meet current standards.</li> </ul>	<b>\$400</b>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Repair Permit</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Replacement of a failing system or relocation of an **existing system, which may include a new septic tank.</li> </ul>	<b>\$300</b>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Septic Tanks, Vault Privy, Pit Privy Permit, Grey Water Sump, Incinerator Toilet, Composting Toilet</b></p>	<b>\$250</b>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Permit Renewal</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 year renewal (extends permit for an additional year from original issuance date)</li> <li>• No limit on number of renewals</li> </ul>	<b>\$100</b>

\* **Approved** - A subsurface sewage disposal system installed after January 1, 1973, which has been permitted, inspected, and approved by a health district (IDAPA 58.01.03.003.03). NOTE: Refer to the 11/07/2014 Notice regarding Connection to an Installed Septic System That Has Never Received Wastewater Flow.

\*\* **Existing** – A subsurface sewage disposal system installed prior to January 1, 1973, which was not permitted or approved by a health district (IDAPA 58.01.03.003.11).
