

- Active influenza season has been declared over in North Idaho. Sporadic cases may continue to occur throughout the year – including the summer months.
- Active RSV season has been declared over in the state of Idaho.
- Several measles outbreaks occurring around the country. To date, no cases of Measles have been identified in North Idaho.
- RSV, CRE, LTBI, TB (B1 and B2 notifications), and, invasive MRSA cases are laboratory reportable only. These cases are not included in yearend numbers.
