

- The 2018-19 influenza season continues. A/H1N1 is the predominant serotype. Based on ER visits, the 25-49-year-old age group appears to be the hardest hit so far this season, but there is activity in all age groups. 3 influenza related deaths so far this season in North Idaho. All in individuals over the age of 50.
- One case of Tick-borne Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever. The case was exposed while recently traveling along the California coast.
- 5 cases of invasive Group A streptococcus.
- Unfortunately, 1 fatal case of Streptococcus Toxic-Shock Syndrome.
