- Five cases of Shiga-Toxin Producing E. coli (STEC) reported in June. No common exposures identified to date. Investigations still ongoing. No serotypes matching to date.
- Two cases of Legionellosis reported in June. No common exposures identified to date. Investigations still ongoing.
- Five cases of Pertussis reported in June. Cases of Pertussis are reported throughout the year, not just in the winter months.
- RSV, CRE, LTBI, TB (B1 and B2 notifications), and, invasive MRSA cases are laboratory reportable only. These cases are not included in yearend numbers.
