FUNDING AVAILABILITY

Per Idaho Statute 39.3135, funds are available for:

- Community consultation and education
- Housing to promote and sustain the ability of individuals with behavioral health disorders to live in the community and avoid institutionalization
- Employment opportunities to promote and sustain the ability of individuals with behavioral health disorders to live in the community and avoid institutionalization
- Evidence-based prevention activities that reduce the burden associated with mental illness and substance use disorders
- Supportive services to promote and sustain the ability of individuals with behavioral health disorders to live in the community and avoid institutionalization including, but not limited to, peer run drop-in centers, support groups, transportation, and family support services

EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE FUNDING REQUESTS

- Educational and/or advertising materials (print, digital, etc) for behavioral health initiatives and programs
- Costs associated with a speaker or event for behavioral health community education
- Purchase or rental of space/equipment/items, such as a movie, for educational events
- Transportation costs for those in mental crisis, treatment, or recovery, to facilitate those activities
- Sponsorship for groups who are promoting behavioral health or recovery support; the R1BHB must receive recognition for the sponsorship

EXAMPLES OF UNACCEPTABLE FUNDING REQUESTS

- Items to be auctioned or raffled off
- Food, decorations, or marketing for social events
- Items which request payment to an individual
- Prize money or winnings
- Scholarships for general education
